

#### This is an important announcement from Bishop Larry J. Kulick:

Good Afternoon/Morning:

As you are aware, we generally have our clergy assignments in the mid-summer of each year. However, due to circumstances beyond our control those assignments had to be delayed to late summer. As you might have guessed that time is upon us now.

It is no secret that we are in a time of a diminishing number of ordained clergy, as well as a shifting, aging and declining demographic reality in many parts of our Diocese.

Without the support of our International Priest Missionaries, we would truly be in a more critical situation. Even with their assistance, and in order to maintain the pastoral care of as many of our parishes as possible, it is necessary to make clergy assignments

that provide for the ongoing pastoral needs of all 78 parishes in the Diocese of Greenburg.

With all of that in mind, I have asked your pastor to inform you, that as of Thursday, August 31, 2023, **Father Dick Anthony Cortado** will be your new Administrator. Father Cortado is coming to you from the parishes of Uniontown. He is one of our International Priests from the Diocese of Tagum.

Your current pastor, Father Marlon Pates will return to the Philippines at that time as required by US Immigration Law. Father Arnel Tadeo will be assigned as Pastor to Saint Patrick's Parish in Brady's Bend.

As we move forward into the future, I am asking all of you, the people and staffs and your Pastoral and Finance Councils to embrace Father Cortado with a spirit of collaboration guided by the Holy Spirit.

Please welcome him with the generosity that you have provided to Fr. Marlon and Father Arnel in their time in your parish.

Please pray for all of our priests and people as we move forward to embrace the future with hope and vitality. Please be assured of my prayers for each of you and for your parish community.

#### 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the midst of our trials and tribulations, the Lord extends His Hands to us and saves us. He calms our frightened hearts through His quiet presence. May our faith in the Lord draw God's chosen people to the new covenant in Christ.

Monday is the Feast of Saint Maximilian Kolbe Born near Lodz, Poland, he founded the Militia of Mary Immaculate, founded several monasteries; missioned in Japan; offered his life at Auschwitz in exchange for the father of a family. He is patron saint of drug addicts, prisoners, families and the pro-life movement.

**Tuesday is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary**, ark of the new covenant, who bore Jesus in her womb. Because she belonged to Christ, Mary our queen is raised on high - a great sign for all who believe in her Son. She shares in the victory promised to all who believe.
