

FAITH FORMATION 2023 / 2024 Faith Formation begins Sunday, September 17.

Next weekend we will begin the process of enrolling students for the 2023 / 2024 Faith Formation year.

Faith Formation begins with four-year olds (Pre-K) and continues through the eighth grade Confirmation Class.

The Sacrament of First Eucharist is received in the second grade; however, students must have completed one year of preparation (Faith Formation or Catholic School) prior to being admitted to the First Eucharist Class.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is received in the eighth grade; however, students must have completed the Seventh Grade Confirmation Preparation Class (Faith Formation or Catholic School) prior to being admitted to the Confirmation Class.

If this requirement is not met, the student will be placed in the first grade or seventh grade preparatory class before being admitted to the corresponding Sacramental Class.

In today's first reading, we hear God tell Isaiah, "my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." We are gathered here today in a house of prayer and so we welcome all people who have come here today to join together to pray to God in praise, petition, and thanksgiving. Let us lift up our voices in prayer to our God.

Mary, Queen of Apostles

In times past, most of the important church festivals were celebrated for eight days. This period of eight days is called an octave. In church tradition, an octave represents eternity and in the early church, it was a symbol of perfection and of heaven.

This Tuesday is the eighth day after the solemnity of the Assumption. We honor Mary as the Regina Caeli, the Queen of Heaven. Psalm 45, sung on Assumption Day, is sung again today. It speaks of a queen in a golden robe. Wherever she goes, she brings justice and splendor and great rejoicing. Jewish songs refer to the Sabbath in that way. When it arrives, it is like a queen whose beauty chases away all sorrow.
