

#### Fr. Marlon's Reflections - Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Dan. 7:9-10, 13-14; 2 Pt. 1:16-19; Matt. 17:1-9



In today's Gospel we have the scene of the transfiguration of Jesus. Jesus took the opportunity to reveal His glory to Peter, James, and John. Peter became so blessed and elated by the experience that he told Jesus to just build tents there so they can stay there. Peter and the apostles had a foretaste of what is to come. Peter was willing to leave his family, livelihood, and land. The experience was so strong. It was also meant to be a preparation for the three in the coming passion and death of Jesus.

Yet, as we know, Peter could not accept Jesus being put to trial and even denied Jesus when asked if he was one of Jesus' followers. Faith is not dependent only on one instance of experiencing the Lord. Faith needs to be tested. Peter learned the hard way.

The key is in the voice from above which comes from the Father; "He is my chosen Son. Listen to Him." The Father introduced Jesus as the Messiah. Furthermore, He commanded everyone to listen to Him. For what are experiences of bliss, mystery, and the divine if it will not result to heeding the words of Jesus? We cannot just bask in the joy of having seen the Lord. The experience should take flesh in our daily lives. That is the best way to show that we really have listened to the Lord.

Every day we hear a lot of voices. We deal with the voices of other people, media, even the evil spirit, and our own voice. The voice of God competes with them. But the choice is ours which voice we will heed. The Father tells us to listen to our Lord. The voice of our Lord does not only address our concerns. The voice of the Lord leads us to salvation. He is the Good Shepherd and we are His sheep. The voice of the shepherd is the life of the sheep. The voice of God is the life of the faithful.


